Completion of the Diploma of Nursing provides guaranteed credit equivalent to the 1st year in undergraduate Nursing degrees at a range of Australian Universities. Alternative pathways include Certificate IV and Diploma qualifications in Aged Care, Disability, Community Services, and other health specialisations.

**Hybrid Packaging** This course can be combined in a hybrid package with either or both of the Certificate III Aged Care and the Certificate III Disability. Graduates of the hybrid packages achieve 2 or 3 qualifications for significantly less cost, and in less time, than taking each course individually. Holding 2 or 3 Cert III qualifications greatly improves graduate employment opportunities, and provides the broadest base of knowledge and skills to support the widest range of jobs in the health and community services industry.
