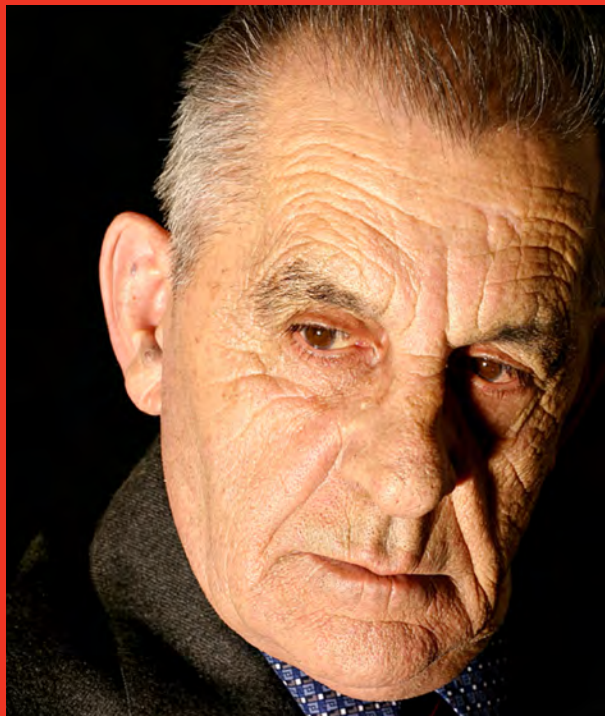
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HIV is now considered to be a chronic health problem, and the past 15 years has seen significant changes in the development of treatment and care. This has enabled people living with HIV (PLHIV) to plan for a long term future.

The HIV Primary Care Coordination Program (HIV PCCP)* is a program which works with the following groups of people:

- > Newly diagnosed with HIV
- > With complex needs
- > Who are new to treatment and care in SA

This is a short term assessment and referral service working with clients and primary care providers to facilitate clients to optimize self management of their health.
