Virtual Hospital

The Virtual Hospital is a video phone, set up in the patients' home, which links directly to the RDNS 24 hour a day call centre, staffed by qualified nurses.

The video phone looks like a standard home telephone with small television screen, is connected to the internet and does not interfere with the normal phone line.

The patient is able to have their consultation when it is convenient to them.
