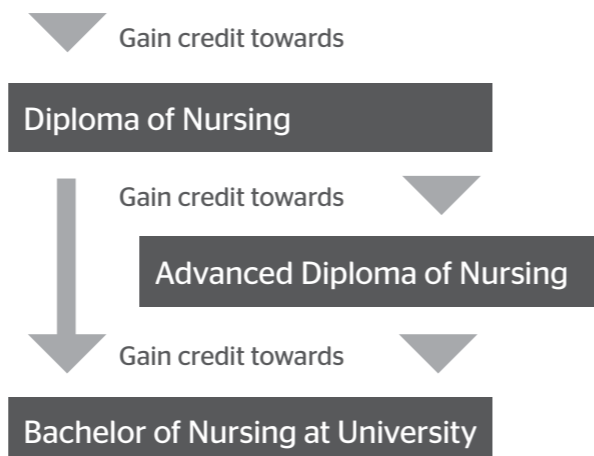

Credit is also granted into the Diploma of Nursing which can reduce the cost and study load of this course.

Nationally Recognised Training

Nationally Recognised Training courses available from the RDNS Education Centre include:

Diploma of Nursing (Enrolled/div 2 nursing)

The course will prepare participants to become Enrolled Nurses who will then be able to provide skilled care to clients in collaboration with a Registered Nurse. With guaranteed credit recognition equivalent to the first year of undergraduate nursing degrees across Australia this is an ideal pathway to RN for those who have that goal.

Certificate III in Aged Care Work

Often essential to work in the booming residential or community aged care industry, this course provides the skills, knowledge and attitudes required to pursue this important and satisfying employment.

Certificate III in Home & Community Care

This course provides the skills and knowledge necessary to deliver care services in the expanding home and community care sector. This course can be packaged with the Certificate III in Aged Care Work to further enhance skills and employment opportunities.
